



# Laborers Construction Fundamentals Training Program

**Location:** JobTrain- 1200 O'Brien Drive, Menlo Park, CA 94025

**Length of Training:** 4 Modules –16 weeks

Module I	Forklift Operation and equipment orientation Safety Certification, CPR, Flagging and Traffic; Introduction to basic tools.
Module II	Environmental Waste Training/OSHA, and confined space
Module III	Concrete mix design, placement and forms, plaster work, brick laying/design techniques, grade checking and blueprint reading
Module IV	Essential Skills and Job Readiness

Instructor may adjust content, length and order of modules as required.

**Days/Time:** Monday through Friday – 8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.

**Entry and Class Requirements:** JobTrain Orientation and WONDERLIC Assessment. Must have ability to communicate clearly in English, have basic math skills, and a desire to work in the trades. May be required to lift 70 lbs. and climb ladders, and should not be sensitive or allergic to fumes and chemical solutions. *Must be drug and alcohol free!* Students must maintain a 90% attendance level.

Vocational English as a Second Language (VESL) classes are available.

**Instructional Outcomes:** HAZWOPER (Hazardous Waste Removal, Asbestos Removal, Lead Removal), OSHA, confined space, blueprint reading, traffic control, use of basic building materials.  
Basic construction skills and math geared toward apprenticeships in the Laborers Union.

**Completion Requirements:** Are based upon entry/class requirements and completing instructional outcomes.

**Career Opportunities:** Laborer occupations; Environmental Health and Safety Firms; Lead and Asbestos Abatement Companies.; Material Handling Opportunities. And Non-Union Contractors.

## **ADMISSION POLICY**

JobTrain vocational training programs are open to students regardless of whether they have graduated from high school, and regardless of their eligibility for funding.

- JobTrain counselors enroll students in classes based on their judgment of the students' ability to benefit from training, considering a broad range of factors including students' academic skills, employability, availability, completion of prerequisite activities or classes, attitudes, and previous training and employment history.
- In case enrollments are limited by class size, priority may be given to students based on availability of funding, education, aptitude, and other factors. Since some funding sources impose particular requirements regarding residence, barriers to employment, Selective Service registration, income, gender, etc., those may be factors considered in prioritization of enrollments.
